Profile 1: A Medium Size NGO

Business Problem: The NGO did not have enough resources to hire a full time database administrator who could take regular database backups, in addition to maintaining their IT systems.

Solution: The accounts team deployed BACCPAC, which with its standard Sage 300 user interfaces and ease of use, allowed the accountants to backup accounting data, without the need for IT professionals.

Results: The NGO was able to handle this crucial task using internal resources.

Profile 2: Furniture Manufacturer

Business Problem: The company had a policy for performing Data Integrity Checks on a weekly basis, to safeguard the integrity of accounting data. Yet, the IT and Accounts Teams could not run this critical process regularly, because their backup systems lacked features for automating it and it was entirely dependent on human discretion.

Solution: The company decided acquiring BACCPAC to run Data Integrity Check independently and unattended, in addition to backups taken by the IT Team, with email alerts sent by BACCPAC to both IT and Accounts Teams.

Results: Excluding the need for human intervention made the process error free and transparent for everyone involved.
